

York GeekFest Code of Conduct and Terms of Service

Whilst attending GeekFest you must adhere to all of the following rules along with generally acting in a way that is polite, safe and respectful of others. York GeekFest reserves the right to remove anyone from the event for any reason if it felt they are disruptive, dangerous or otherwise causing issue with others enjoyment of the event.

Photography

York GeekFest will have a dedicated event photographer. There will also be other press photographers from local news outlets at the event. They will be denoted by their official press pass and a list of all the approved press members will be available at the main desk. By attending GeekFest you are giving permission for your photograph to be taken and used by York GeekFest for promotional purposes and any of the approved press persons. If you explicitly do not wish for your photograph to be used please inform the photographer.

Private photography is allowed at the event however permission from all identifiable parties in the photograph must be obtained.

Harassment

GeekFest is dedicated to providing a harassment-free and safe event for everyone, regardless of sex, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, age, or religion or belief. We do not tolerate harassment of attendees in any form.

Clothing

All attendees must comply with the rules on what clothing is appropriate available in the Cosplay information which is freely available as a downloadable PDF on the GeekFest Website. Those who do not adhere to these rules will be expelled from the event.

Children

Children are welcome at GeekFest however all children must be accompanied and supervised at the event. Parents must also be aware that not all event at GeekFest are suitable for young children and discretion must be used.

Safety

GeekFest wants to provide a safe event for all involved so any who is acting in an unsafe manner or who is in the possession of items deemed dangerous will be asked to leave.

Attendees violating this code of conduct will be expelled from the event
